The Schools of Graduate and Professional Programs (SGPP) serve over 4500 students through relevant and innovative educational programs, experiences and enterprises. Dedicated to serving both adult learners and the educational needs of society, SGPP offers its programs on its Twin Cities and Winona campuses, as well as in Apple Valley, Rochester, Minnetonka, throughout greater Minnesota, Wisconsin and internationally in Jamaica and Nairobi, Kenya.

Saint Mary's serves its surrounding communities through the Lasallian Day of Service, involving students, alumni and friends of the university in service projects, through professional artist performances, exhibits, and concerts open to the public, and through its athletic facilities, ropes course, hiking and cross country ski trails, which provide multiple opportunities to all community members.

Scholarships and Financial Aid: Approximately 90% of undergraduate students receive financial aid, including over \$14 million in scholarships and grants from the university through annual and endowed scholarships, as well as through the annual Saint Mary's Fund.
